



As we requested, the General Counsel has designated a member of his staff to assist Drs. Trifunac and Luco in their appearances as Board witnesses in the reopening seismic hearings. See ALAB-604, 12 NRC ____, ____ (August 7, 1980) (slip opinion at 5-6). Mrs. Marjorie S. Nordlinger, the attorney who will provide that assistance, provided similar representation to those individuals in earlier hearings before the Licensing Board. Yesterday, Mrs. Nordlinger filed and served a formal "Notice of Continuation of Appearance" which requested, among other things, that service be made upon her in the future.

Accordingly, all papers in the reopened seismic hearings shall henceforth be served on Mrs. Nordlinger at the address

Similarly, any party wishing to contact those Board witnesses (other than to deliver written testimony to them) should make advance arrangements to do so through that counsel. The Board wishes to be kept informed of such contacts.
