Dear Chairman Ahearne:

It is imperative that the Diablo Canyon nuclear facilities be certified for start-up operations and that plans for fiscal year 1981-82 be developed without delay. Otherwise, California faces the possibility of serious power shortages.

The electronics industry, which is heavily impacted in my Senatorial District, and other critically important industries and activities will be seriously threatened with power interruptions which would adversely affect employment, the economy, and the ability of California's industry to compete, both domestically and overseas, if Diablo Canyon does not receive prompt certification.

I cannot stress too strongly my belief that the power waiting to be generated by Diablo Canyon is essential to the well-being of both California and the nation.
