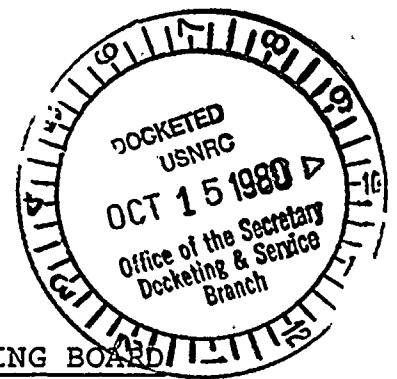

MOTION OF GOVERNOR EDMUND G. BROWN, JR.
FOR REVISION OF SCHEDULE

Governor Brown is in receipt of this Board's October 6, 1980, Order regarding the PG&E motion for fuel loading and low power testing. In the Order, this Board fixes October 27, 1980, as the date for filing of contentions and issues. We respectfully move that the Board defer the scheduled October 27, 1980, date. Our reasons are the following:

1. The reopened seismic hearing in this case commences on October 20, 1980, in San Luis Obispo. We will be there during that entire week and the preceding three days.
2. Discovery is continuing on the security plan issue through October 21, and written testimony for the security plan hearing must be filed with the Appeal Board on October 29, 1980.
3. The security plan hearing in this case commences on or about November 10, 1980.



The foregoing obligations to prepare for previously set hearings preclude us from analyzing materials and preparing issues on fuel loading and low power testing for submittal to this Board by October 27, 1980. Indeed, given the complexity of the multiple hearings and obligations pending in this overall proceeding, any date for filing issues prior to December 3, 1980, would impose a severe hardship which would preclude the Governor's opportunity to participate effectively. Accordingly, we move for deferral of the October 27, 1980 filing date until December 3, 1980.
