I. SECY-17-0021 – SUSQUEHANNA NUCLEAR, LLC (SUSQUEHANNA STEAM
ELECTRIC STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2); APPEAL OF LBP-16-12 (AFFIRMING DENIAL
OF ACCESS TO SUNSI) AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a request by Mr. Sabatini Monatesti for a hearing on the application of Susquehanna Nuclear, LLC, for an indirect transfer of control of its interests in the operating licenses for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, and in the general license for the station's Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. Mr. Monatesti also requested access to sensitive, unclassified, non-safeguards information (SUNSI) withheld from the publicly available record. The NRC staff denied Mr. Monatesti's request for access to the SUNSI, and in LBP-16-12 an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board affirmed the staff's decision. Mr. Monatesti appealed the Board's decision. The Memorandum and Order affirms the Board's decision and denies Mr. Monatesti's request for a hearing.
