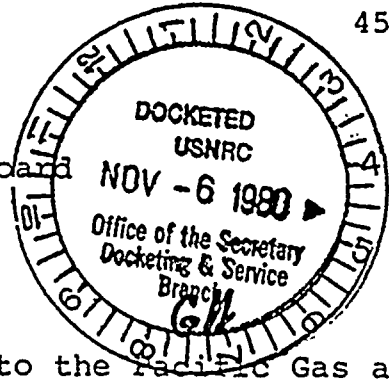

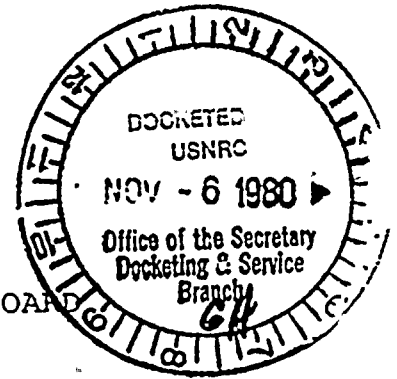

## Diablo worker key in bust

A young construction worker with an unkempt beard and a Boston accent was the informant who led law enforcement officers to arrest 31 people this week on charges of selling drugs, Sheriff George S. Whiting confirmed Friday.

The informant, who used the name "Alan," worked as a laborer at the Diablo Canyon nuclear power plant until being laid off about a month ago, Whiting said.

Alan was on hand at the gates of Diablo near Port San Luis on Wednesday afternoon, pointing out five employees as they got off work to deputies who arrested them.

None of the incidents leading to the drug charges occurred at the Diablo, Whiting said.

One Avila Beach resident described Alan as an outgoing man in his early 20's

who was frequently seen around the community until about a month ago when he dropped out of sight.

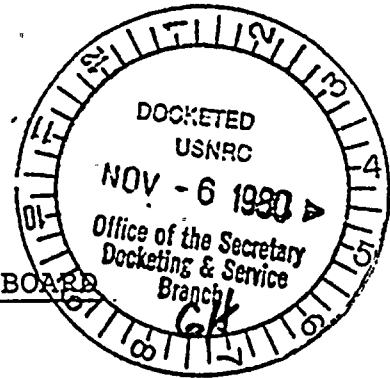
"He didn't say goodbye to anyone."

Pacific Gas and Electric Co. spokesman Richard P. Davin said two of those arrested, Kevin K. Weaver of Avila Beach and Larry W. Houle of Oceano, had been Pinkerton guards who were fired as a result of the arrests.

The other three Diablo employees were construction workers David A. Colacchio of Avila Beach and Marvin O. Mann Jr. of Oceano, both of whom worked for Howard P. Foley Co., and Thomas S.
