The prescribed dose for the treatment was 125 Gy. After the patient treatment, the licensee discovered that a calculation error had occurred. The licensee implanted 110 seeds (184.8 mCi) that delivered ~ 172 Gy instead of the 80 seeds (134.4 mCi) that would have delivered ~ 125 Gy. The error resulted in an overexposure to the prostrate.
