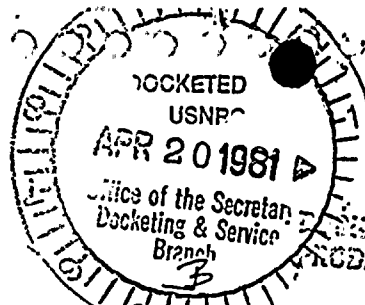
I am a resident of San Luis Obispo & as such am concerned with the safety of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.

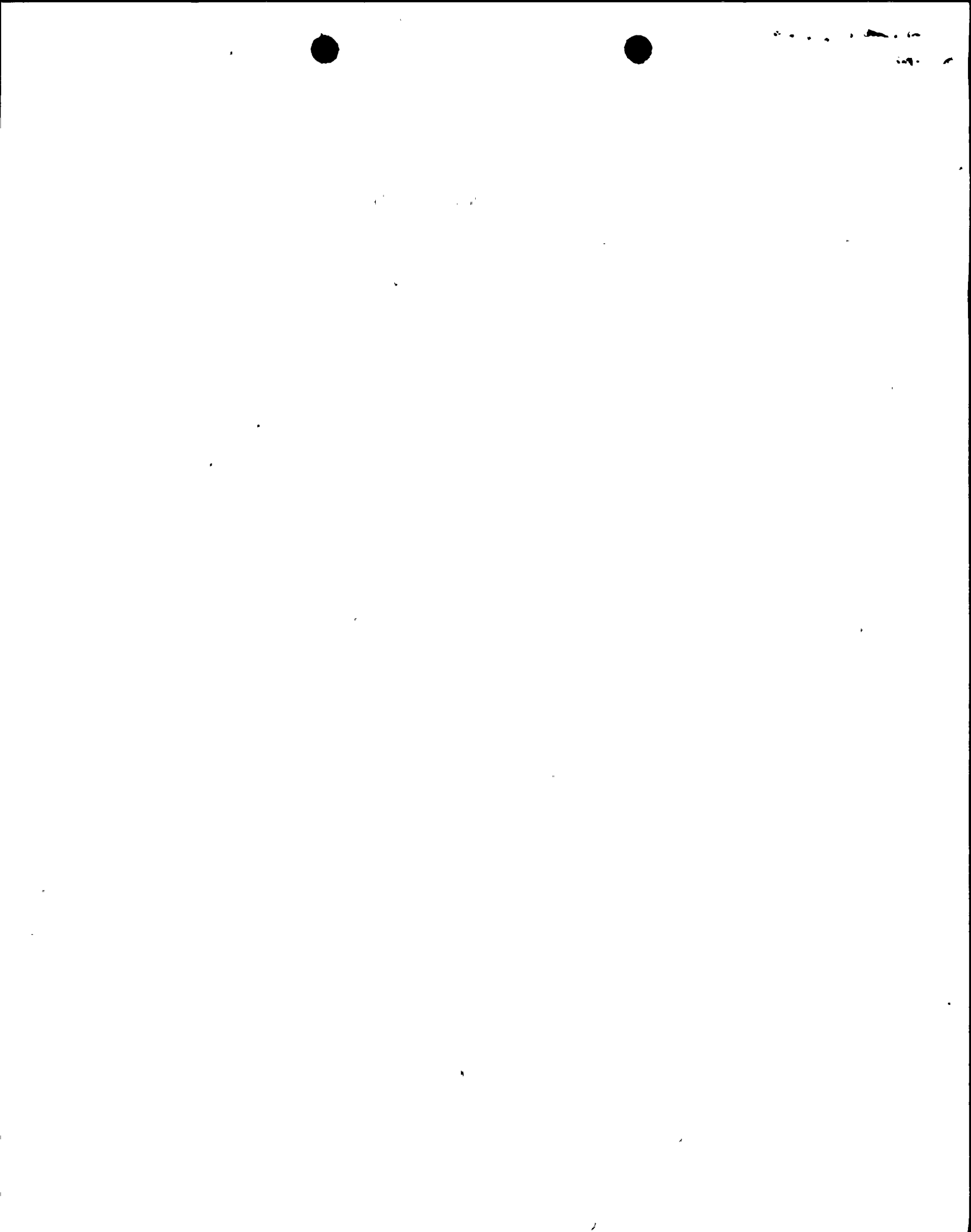

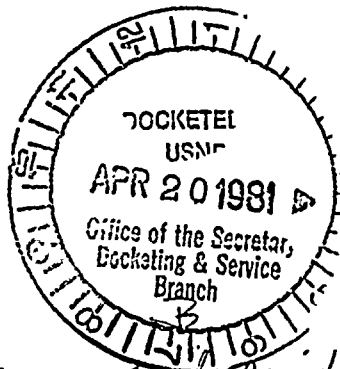
