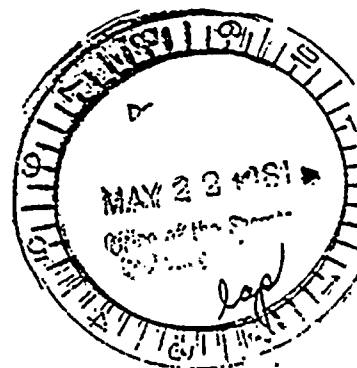
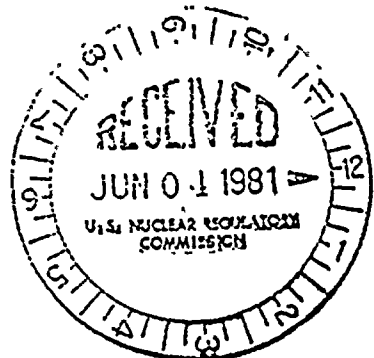
DEAR SIR:

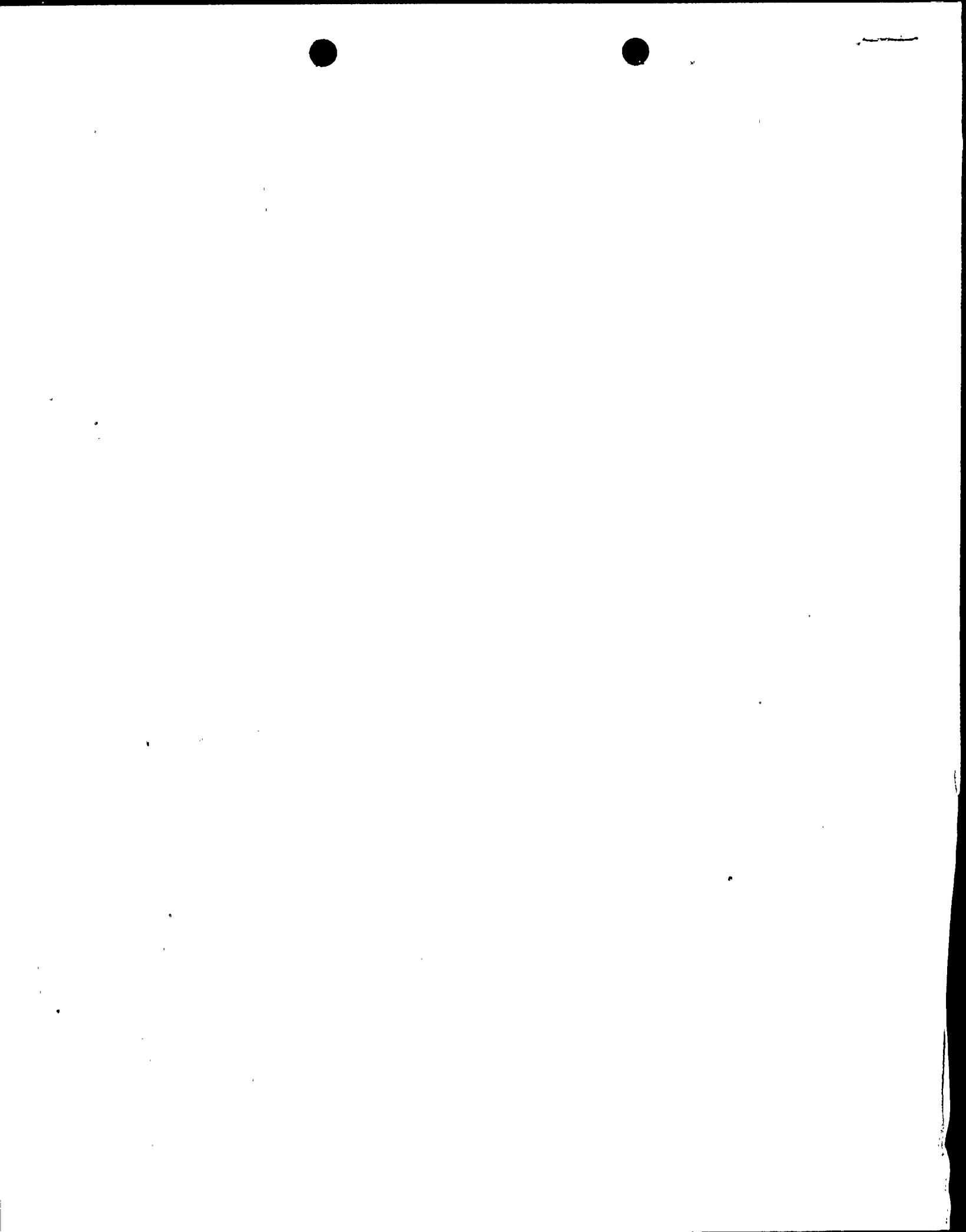

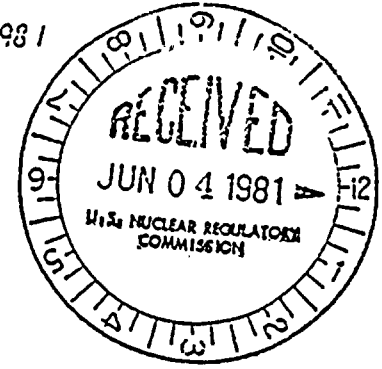

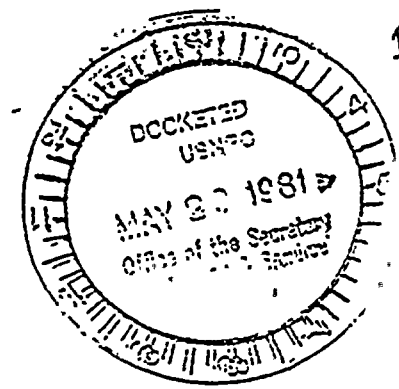
