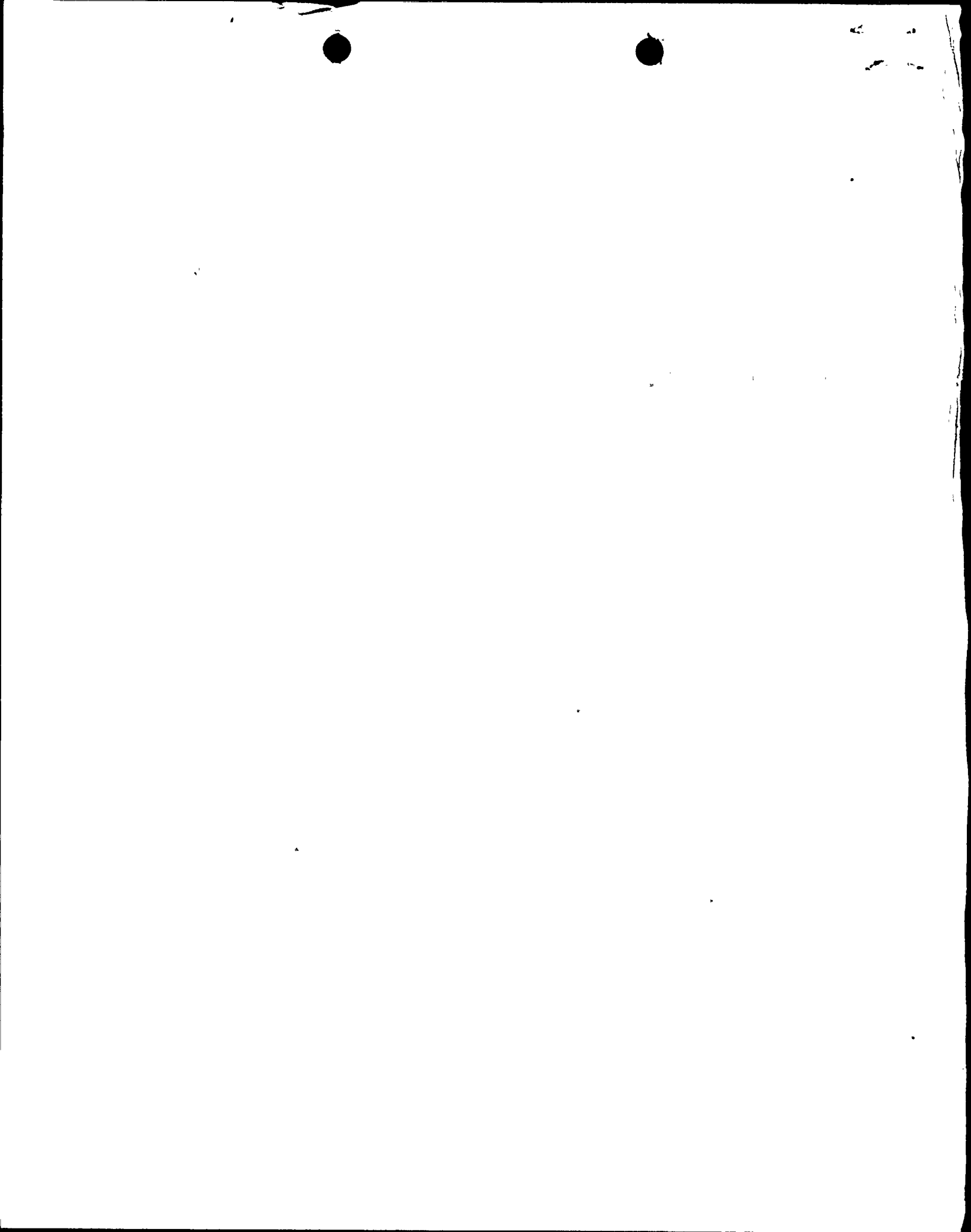

Canyon Nuclear Power Plant

Attached are copies of the Exercise Reports for the September 23, 1987, full participation plume pathway joint exercise and the October 28, 1987, ingestion pathway exercise of the offsite REP plans for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. The State of California and San Luis Obispo County, which is located in the 10-mile plume emergency planning zone (EPZ), participated in the exercises.

The exercise reports were prepared by the Region IX staff of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). There were no deficiencies identified during these exercises. A schedule of corrective actions is included in the exercise reports which addresses the areas requiring corrective actions. The Region will assure completion by the State of the necessary corrective actions.

Based upon the results of these exercises, there continues to be reasonable assurance that appropriate protective measures can be implemented by the offsite jurisdictions around the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency.
