On December 13, 1988, the NRC Staff requested additional information regarding PG&E's Long Term Seismic Program Final Report. The request included 47 questions and a proposed response schedule. PG&E letter DCL-88-321, dated December 30, 1988, stated that responses to the questions would be provided in accordance with the requested schedule, except for questions 16, 46, and parts of 43, which would be provided by February 28, 1989.

On January 16, 1989, PG&E submitted responses in letter DCL-89-010 to questions 34-38 relating to the probabilistic risk assessment. Enclosed are responses to questions 1-3, 40-42, parts of 43, 44-45, and 47. Responses to the remaining questions previously scheduled for submittal on this date will follow in a few days.

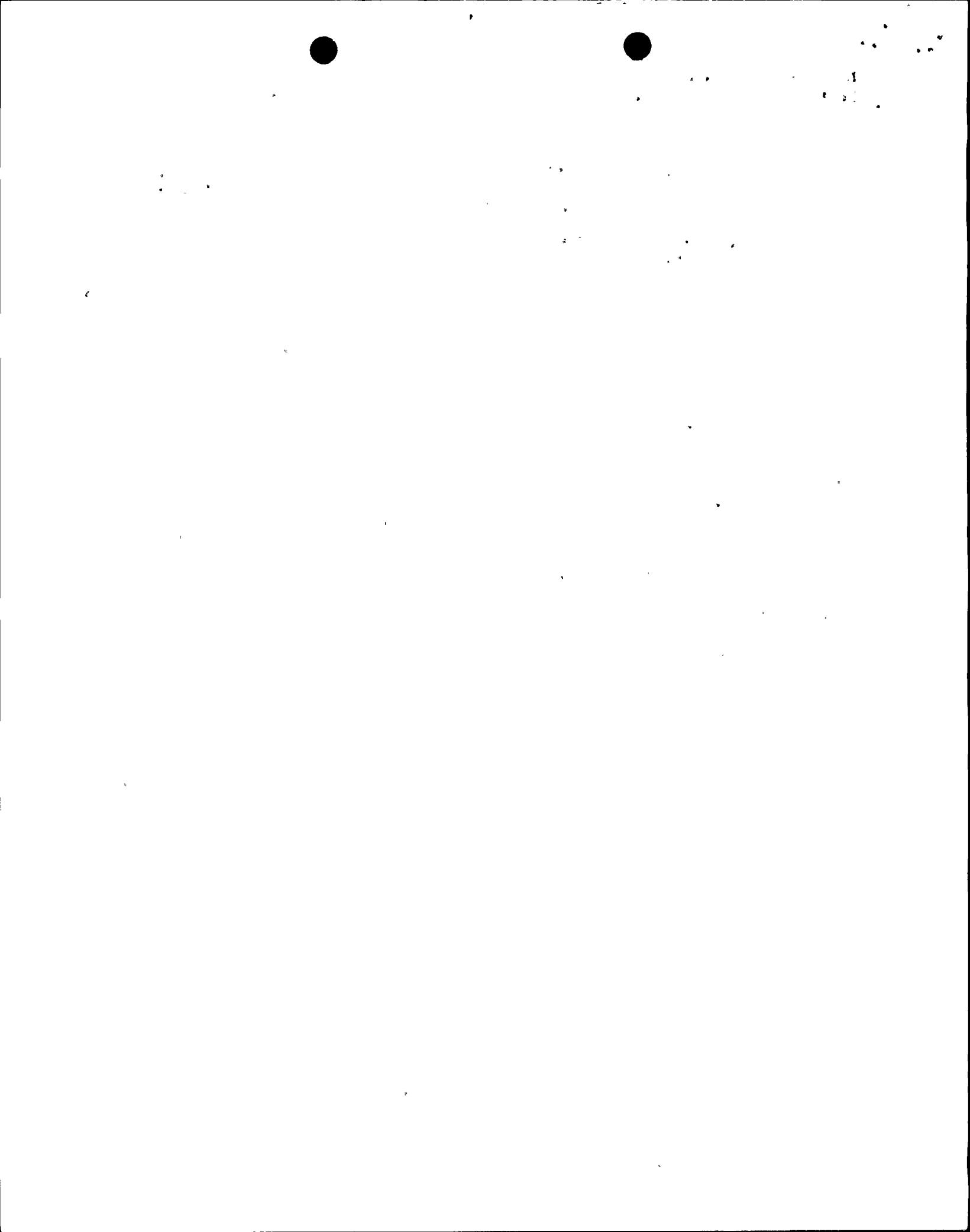

It is respectfully requested that the appropriately marked information that is proprietary to BPC be withheld from public disclosure.
