**Office of Enforcement Alternative Dispute Regulation Services**

On March 8, 2017, contract number NRC-HQ-7B-17-C-0001 was awarded to Cornell University in Ithaca, NY. The objective of this contract is to provide alternative dispute regulation services for the Office of Enforcement. The period of performance of this contract is from March 27, 2017, through March 26, 2018, with four 1-year option periods. The total potential value over the life of the contract is \$900,000.

**Regulatory Improvements for Power Reactors Transitioning to Decommissioning: Draft Regulatory Basis; Request for Comment; Parts 26, 50, 52, 73, and 140 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (Regulation Identifier Number 3150-AJ59; NRC-2015-0070)**

On March 15, 2017, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([82 FR 13778](#)) requesting public comments on a draft regulatory basis to support a rulemaking that would amend the NRC's regulations for the decommissioning of nuclear power reactors. The NRC plans to hold a public meeting to discuss the draft regulatory basis and facilitate public comment. Comments are due by June 13, 2017.

**Japanese Nuclear Regulatory Authority Visitors**

On March 6, 2017, a five-member delegation from Japan's Nuclear Regulatory Authority (NRA) began a 9-week assignment with the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. The purpose of the assignment is to learn the NRC's regulatory oversight program for operating reactors and to take back to NRA for consideration. The delegation has already spent 8 months working in the regional offices and at the Technical Training Center.

**2016 End-of-Cycle Summary Meeting**

On March 8, 2017, the staff conducted the 2016 End-of-Cycle Summary Meeting to discuss with the regions regulatory actions taken for reactor licensees demonstrating performance issues in 2016. The staff concluded that Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2, and Pilgrim meet the criteria for discussion at the Agency Action Review Meeting (AARM) scheduled for May 2017.
