

Subject: Delegation of Authority, Radiation Safety Officer, St. Louis Office

You, Craig M. Brooks, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer for the St. Louis office of Shannon & Wilson, Inc. and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the Radiation Safety Program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise and discuss issues and concerns with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend on average one to two hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.
