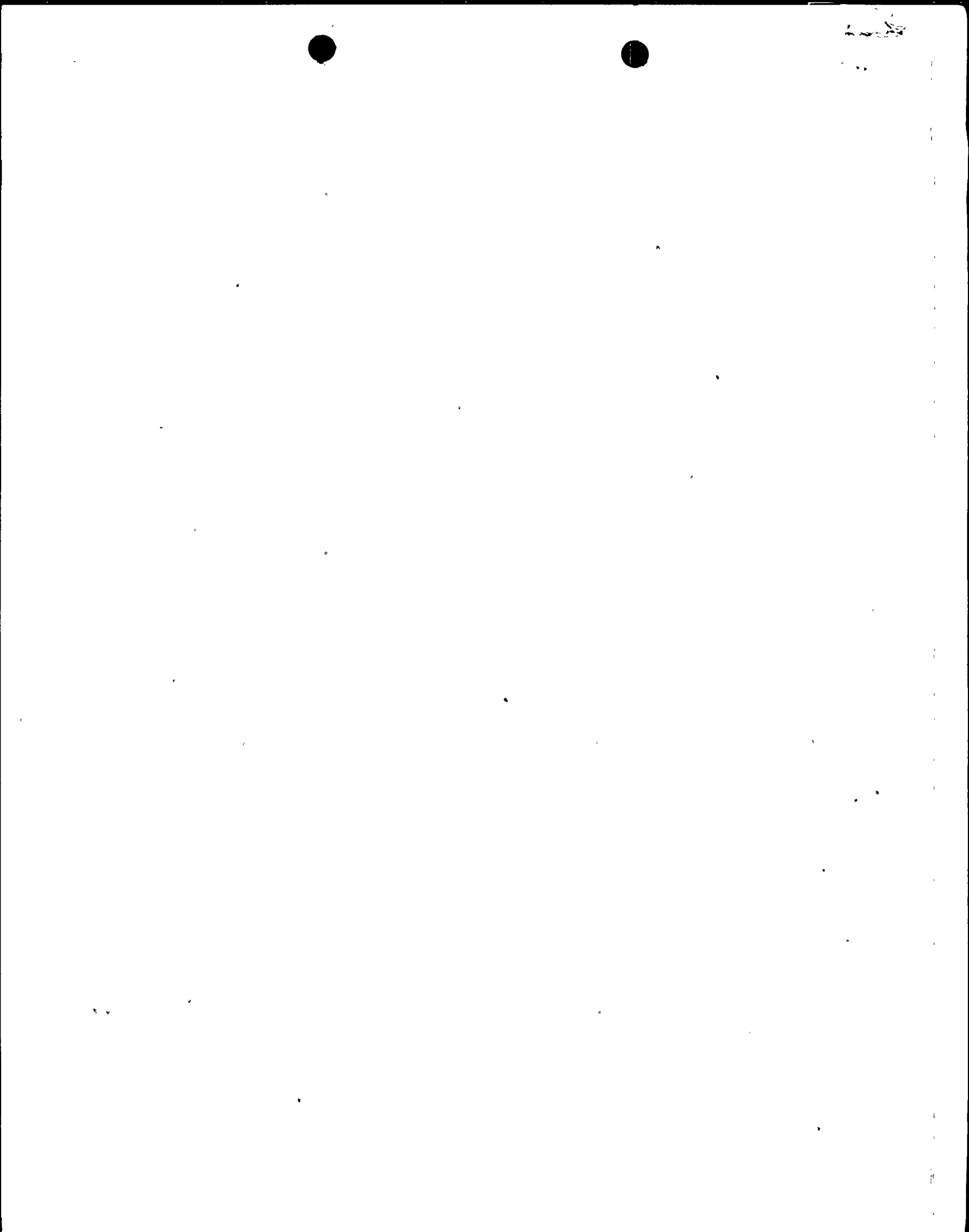

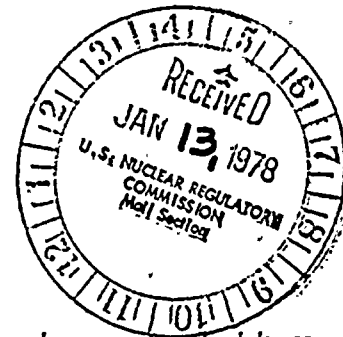

Dear Mr. Stolz:

This is the promised additional reply to your letter of November 4, 1977.

In response to IE Bulletin 77-04 Westinghouse has reviewed the design and operating bases of the containment spray system subsequent to the addition of sodium hydroxide to the containment sump water inventory following a loss-of-coolant accident. This review utilized the appropriate Diablo Canyon Nuclear Plant technical specification and operating limits and reaffirmed the minimum containment sump pH presently specified in Section 6.2.3 of the Diablo Canyon Final Safety Analysis Report.

Therefore, Westinghouse concludes that the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Plant meets all design requirements concerning the pH of containment sump water and that no additional action is required in response to the above mentioned NRC bulletin.
