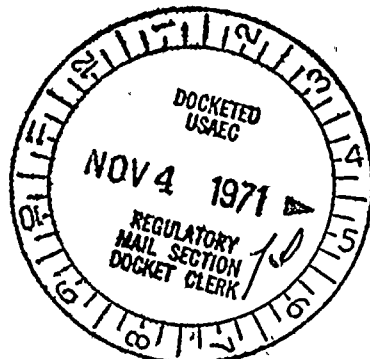

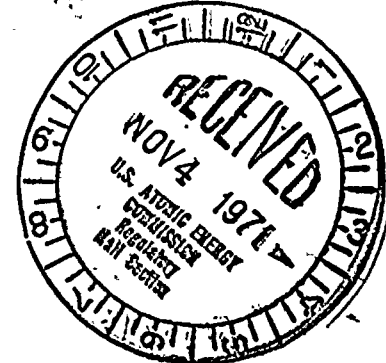



Gentlemen:

The Certificate of Conformance with water quality standards which you requested on April 30, 1971, is enclosed. This certificate is to accompany your request for a construction permit from the Atomic Energy Commission to construct Units 1 and 2 of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.

Please note that conditions have been included to reduce the allowable limit for oil in the discharge and to prohibit the discharge of sewage effluent into the ocean. These conditions are designed to ensure compliance with existing water quality control policy of the State and federal government.


The State Water Resources Control Board finds:

1. The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied to the United States Atomic Energy Commission for a permit to construct Units 1 and 2 of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.
2. A certification of conformance with applicable water quality standards by the state is required before the Atomic Energy Commission can act on the application.
3. Waste discharge requirements were adopted for this discharge on October 17, 1969. The discharge is subject to the provisions of the Policy Regarding The Control Of Temperature In The Coastal And Interstate Waters And Enclosed Bays And Estuaries Of California adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board on October 13, 1971. The discharge is also subject to the Water Quality Control Policy for Pacific Coastal Waters (Point Arguello to Point Piedras Blancas) adopted by the State Board on May 17, 1967.
4. The State Board is designated by Section 13160 of the Water Code as the state water pollution control agency for all purposes stated in the Federal Water Pollution Control Act and any other federal act heretofore or hereafter enacted.
5. The Executive Officer of the State Board is authorized to take all actions in connection with applications for certification except when public hearing is held.
6. There is reasonable assurance that the above described activity by Pacific Gas and Electric Company will be conducted in a manner which will not violate applicable water quality standards and it is so certified with the following conditions:

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- (a) The concentration of oil in the discharge shall not exceed .01 mg/l at any time.
- (b) Direct discharge of sewage effluent to the ocean is prohibited.
