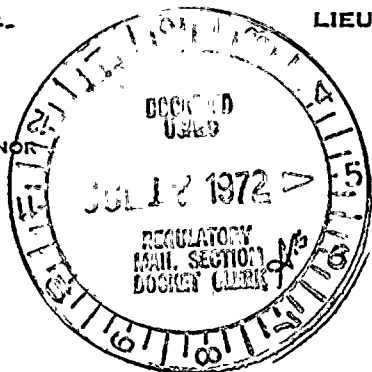

Dear Mr. Schwencer:

We were pleased to receive the information package and Amendment No. 2 to the Environmental Report on the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 1.

The State of California is very interested in conducting a thorough, detailed analysis of the project and the environmental impact. This office is the central point of dissemination to the various State departments involved in the review process under the requirements of OMB Circular A-95.

To facilitate that review, it will be necessary for us to receive, as soon as possible, 20 complete packages for dissemination to State departments for their review and comment. When the documents are received, the State will then initiate a 60 day review which is well within the 90 day review time frame spelled out in the President's Council on Environmental Quality guidelines which implemented the National Environmental Policy Act.

This letter is also to officially notify the Atomic Energy Commission that these procedures should be followed on all pending and future Atomic Energy Commission projects in California.
