Enclosed is Amendment No. 01 renewing your NRC Materials License No. 21-32607-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

By letter dated December 2, 2016, BluePearl Michigan, LLC, submitted to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to Direct License Transfer of NRC Materials License No. 21-32607-01. Based on the information provided, along with information provided earlier in letter dated August 2, 2016, we understand that as a result of a purchase by BluePearl Global, LLC, a subsidiary of Mars, Inc., BluePearl Michigan, LLC transferred to a new parent company, changing the control of the license. We further understand that this transfer did not result in any change to the licensed material, persons using the licensed material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program. The only substantive change was a change in the parent company structure.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the transfer. It is our understanding that the effective date of the transfer was November 19, 2015. By the aforementioned letter dated December 2, 2016, it was confirmed that this transaction was finalized.


Please note that we have incorporated this information in with the renewal of this license that was underway while the change of control was being evaluated.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
