



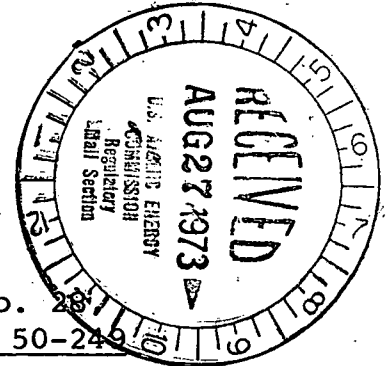
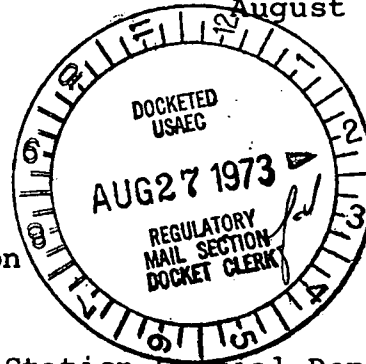

Addendum 2, AEC Dkts 50-237 and 50-246

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

The attached Addendum to Special Report No. 28, "Analyses & Procedures for Handling General Electric IF-300 Spent Fuel Shipping Cask," documents information provided your staff in a meeting July 27, 1973. The Addendum is arranged in three (3) sections: Section 1 discusses the design of the reactor building crane braking system, the crane hook, the lifting limit switches and crane operator qualifications; Section 2 responds to sixteen (16) questions from your staff concerning reactor building crane design and operation; Section 3 discusses additional information concerning requests for additional structural information. This addendum completes our response to all questions concerning handling the General Electric IF-300 Spent Fuel Shipping Cask at Dresden Station Unit 2.

The IF-300 spent fuel cask is now available for preliminary handling demonstrations without fuel ("dry run") at Dresden Station. Based on the information provided in Dresden Special Report No. 28 and Addenda 1 and 2 it is clear that the IF-300 spent fuel cask can be used at Dresden Station without hazard to public health and safety. The dry run is being delayed awaiting your concurrence.

After General Electric receives the license for use of the IF-300 cask it is scheduled to begin spent fuel shipment from Dresden Unit 2 to the Midwest Fuel Recovery Plant immediately. Spent fuel shipment will also be delayed pending your concurrence to use the cask at Dresden Unit 2. A prompt conclusion of your review is warranted.


