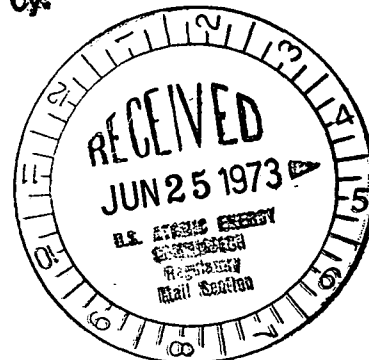

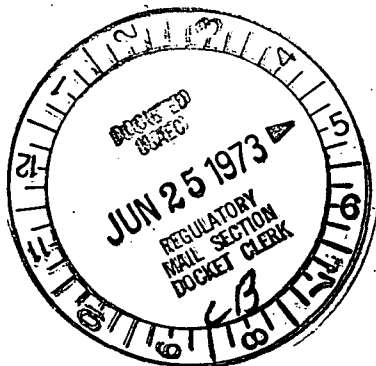
As requested by Mr. D. J. Skovholt's letter of March 6, 1973, and by the Directorate of Regulatory Operations on April 28, 1972, enclosed are analyses of stresses on main steam safety and relief valves at Dresden Units 2 and 3. These reports indicate that the stress performance of valves and piping will be satisfactory at the design conditions with dynamic loadings.

An evaluation of the applicability of this report to Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2, AEC Dockets 50-254 and 50-265 is presently being performed. It is anticipated that this evaluation will be submitted to the Commission by August 1, 1973.
