Confirmation of verbal contact made April 3, 2017: Monitor well M-1538 for wellfields 15/15A was scheduled to be sampled the last 3 days in March. A malfunction associate with the well pump could not be resolved in a timely manner. Monitor wells are sampled according to Permit 633, Operations Plan Section 8.2, (NRC license SUA-1548, Section 5.2.2) at a frequency of twice per month not less than 10 days apart. The sampling event will be skipped.

Well M-1538 is not near excursion status. The skipped sampling should have no impacts to the monitoring of the wellfield.

In accordance to the Permit 633, Section 8.2, a written notification will be submitted within 15 days (on or before April 14, 2017) to discuss any impacts from the missed sampling. The event will also be described in the 2016-2017 Annual Report submitted on or before June 18, 2017 and in the Q1 Excursion Monitoring Report for 2017.

In accordance to the NRC License SUA-1548, condition 12.1, this event reportable to the WDEQ is to be verbally reported to the NRC and copied on the written notification. A self-identified violation will be placed in our NRC files.
