ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: Yes, it's on Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station). The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to Pilgrim Watch's request for a hearing on a request submitted by Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. for relaxation of Nuclear Regulatory Commission order EA-13-109 at the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station. EA-13-109 is an NRC post-Fukushima order regarding installation of reliable hardened containment vents. Pilgrim Watch contends that Entergy's request is actually a license amendment application with accompanying hearing rights. The Commission, with Commissioner Baran offering additional views, has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that denies Pilgrim Watch's hearing request and refers the filings in this matter to the NRC Staff for consideration in connection with Entergy's request.
