The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) acknowledges receipt of your letter dated March 28, 2017, conveying the initial voluntary self-disclosure on behalf of the Source Production and Equipment Co., Inc. (SPEC) regarding possible violations to 10 CFR Part 110. Based on the information provided, the NRC grants SPEC an extension of thirty (30) days from the NRC's receipt of the subject correspondence on March 29, 2017, for SPEC to conclude its internal audit and complete this Voluntary Self-Disclosure. We look forward to receiving the supplemental information described in your letter, which is expected to include: 1) a more detailed discussion of the circumstances surrounding this matter; 2) documentation relating to the involved importations of sealed disused sources and disposition thereof, including the isotopes and total activities imported; 3) an explanation of the corrective actions taken by SPEC in response to management's discovery of the apparent violations; and 4) factors for the NRC to consider in mitigation of the apparent violations disclosed by SPEC.
