STATEMENT OF INTENT

As Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs of West Virginia University (WVU) I exercise express authority and responsibility to request from West Virginia University funds for decommissioning activities associated with operations authorized by U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Material license No. 47-23035-01. This authority is established by WVU Board of Governors Operating Procedures. Within this authority, I intend to request that funds be made available when necessary in the amount of \$1,125,000 (one million and one hundred and twenty five thousand dollars) to decommission West Virginia University, One Medical Center Drive Morgantown, WV 26506. I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.

A copy of WVU Board of Governors Operating Procedures is attached as evidence that I am authorized to represent West Virginia University in this transaction.
