

Additional Information on Vessel

and Piping, NRC Dkts. 50-237 and 50-249

Dear Mr. Silver:

This is to confirm the information given to you in our telephone conversation of February 13, 1975.

The vessels for Dresden Units 2 and 3 were placed on December 8, 1968 and January 4, 1970, respectively.

Welding records show that the core spray lines in Dresden Unit 2 were being installed between October 1968 and May 1969 and hydro-tested in March 1969, except for the few welds completed in April and May of 1969. The core spray lines on Dresden Unit 3 were installed between April 1969 and May 1970 and were hydrotested in May 1970.

The bypass piping was hydro-tested on Dresden Units 2 and 3 on January 1970 and May 1970, respectively.
