The upgrading of cable penetrations and fire stops discussed in references (a), (b), and (c) have been completed for Quad-Cities Station Units 1 and 2 and Dresden Station Unit 2. A few cable pans in high radiation areas, remote from the control room, remain to be sealed during the fall of 1976 refueling outage for Dresden Unit 3.
