- SUBJECT: INTEGRATED ACTION PLAN TO MODERNIZE DIGITAL INSTRUMENTATION AND CONTROLS REGULATORY INFRASTRUCTURE, REVISION 1 (CAC NO. MF8115)

Enclosed for information and use is Revision 1 to the integrated action plan (IAP), to modernize the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) digital instrumentation and control regulatory infrastructure. This is the first revision to the IAP since being approved for implementation by the Commission per the Staff Requirements Memorandum (SRM) for SECY-16-0070, "Integrated Strategy to Modernize the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Digital Instrumentation and Control Regulatory Infrastructure," dated October 25, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML16299A157). The IAP will continue to be reviewed and updated at least semi-annually with approval of the steering committee to indicate progress made within each activity and identify, plan, and prioritize future activities.

The IAP builds upon ongoing regulatory activities, stakeholder feedback on the current IAP, specific Commission direction in SRM-SECY-16-0070 and SRM-SECY-15-0106, "Proposed Rule: Incorporation by Reference of Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers

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Standard 603-2009, IEEE Standard Criteria for Safety Systems for Nuclear Power Generating Stations," dated February 25, 2016 (ADAMS Accession No. ML16056A614), as well as evaluation of comments received through internal and external stakeholder interactions. The IAP is a living document, therefore, your input will be taken into consideration as the IAP is revised in the future. At appropriate stages, the NRC staff will continue to engage the industry in demonstration activities, tabletops, etc. to test planned processes, guidance, etc. before they are finalized for implementation.
