NRC STAFF STATUS REPORT TO COMMISSION ON TURKEY POINT CONSULTATIONS

Pursuant to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Staff's January 11, 2017, Response to the Commission's Memorandum and Order (CLI-17-01, dated January 4, 2017) the Staff hereby provides the Commission the status of consultations with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) and National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) regarding the Florida Power and Light Company combined license application for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7.

The Staff has been in continued communication with both agencies but has no additional information regarding the dates for completion of consultation. Consistent with the Staff's January 11, 2017, Response to the Commission, the Staff continues to anticipate that consultation with both the FWS and the NMFS under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act will be completed on or about May 31, 2017.

The Staff will provide another update on the status of the consultations to the Commission on or before that date.
