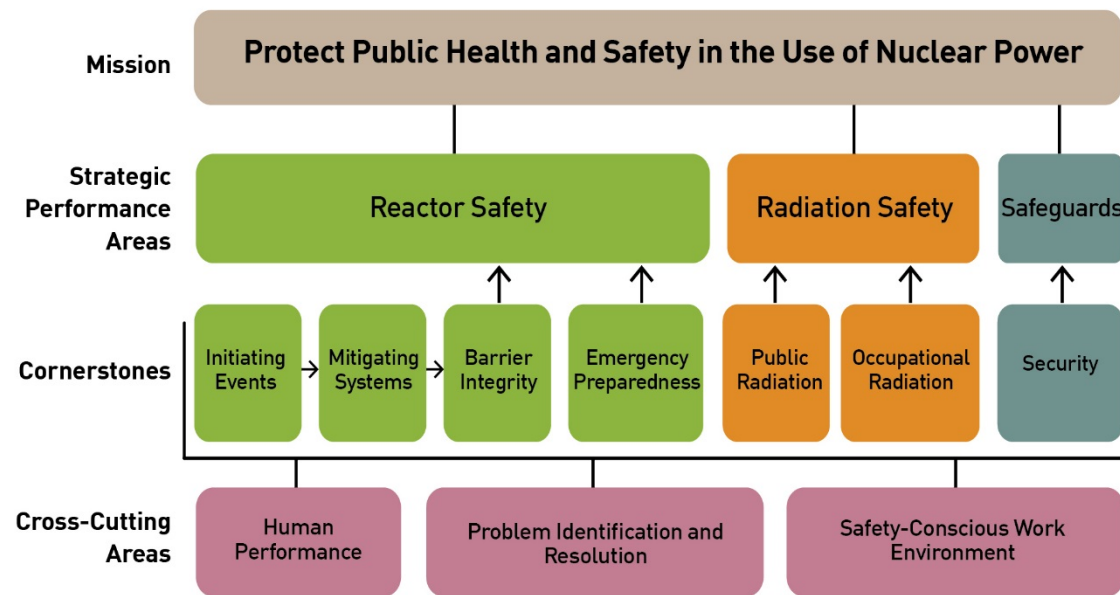

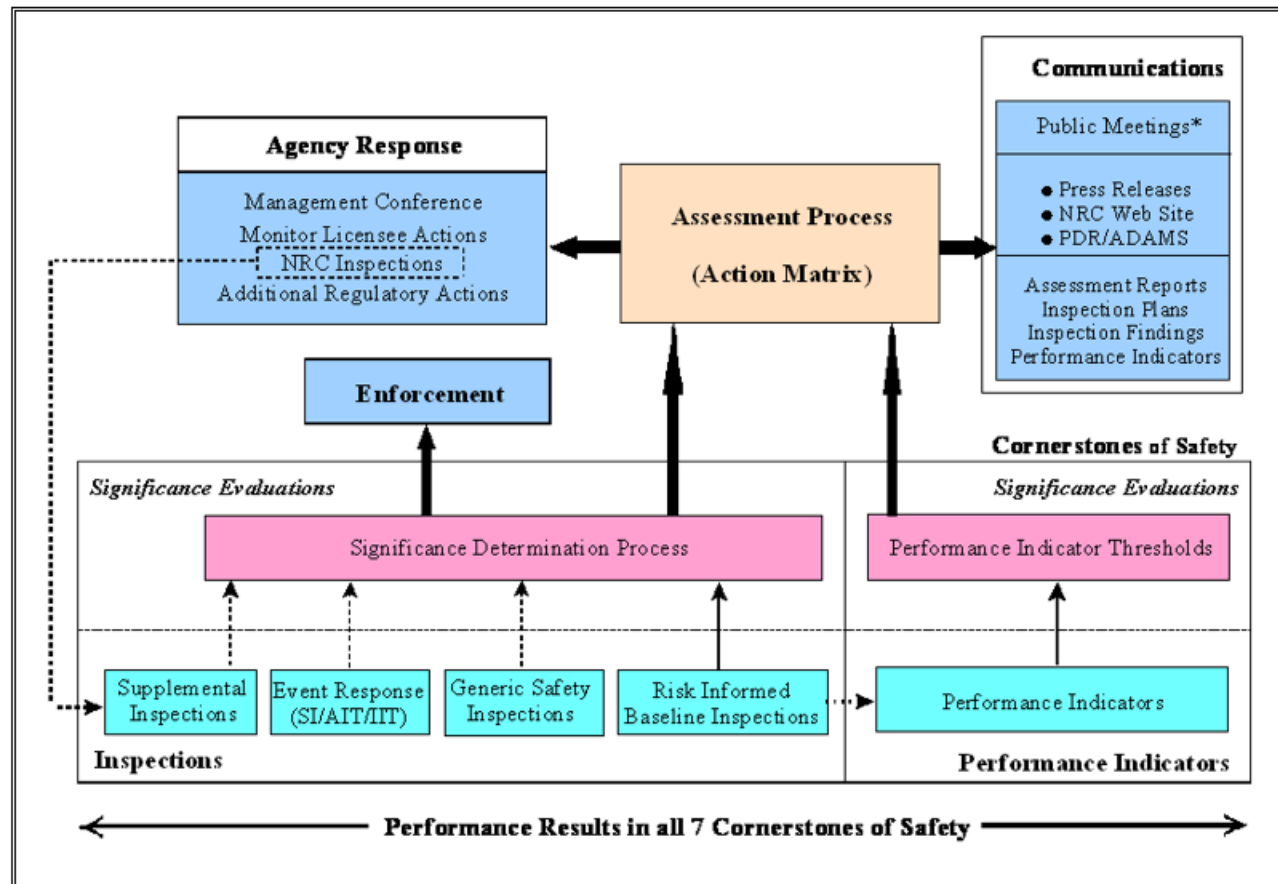

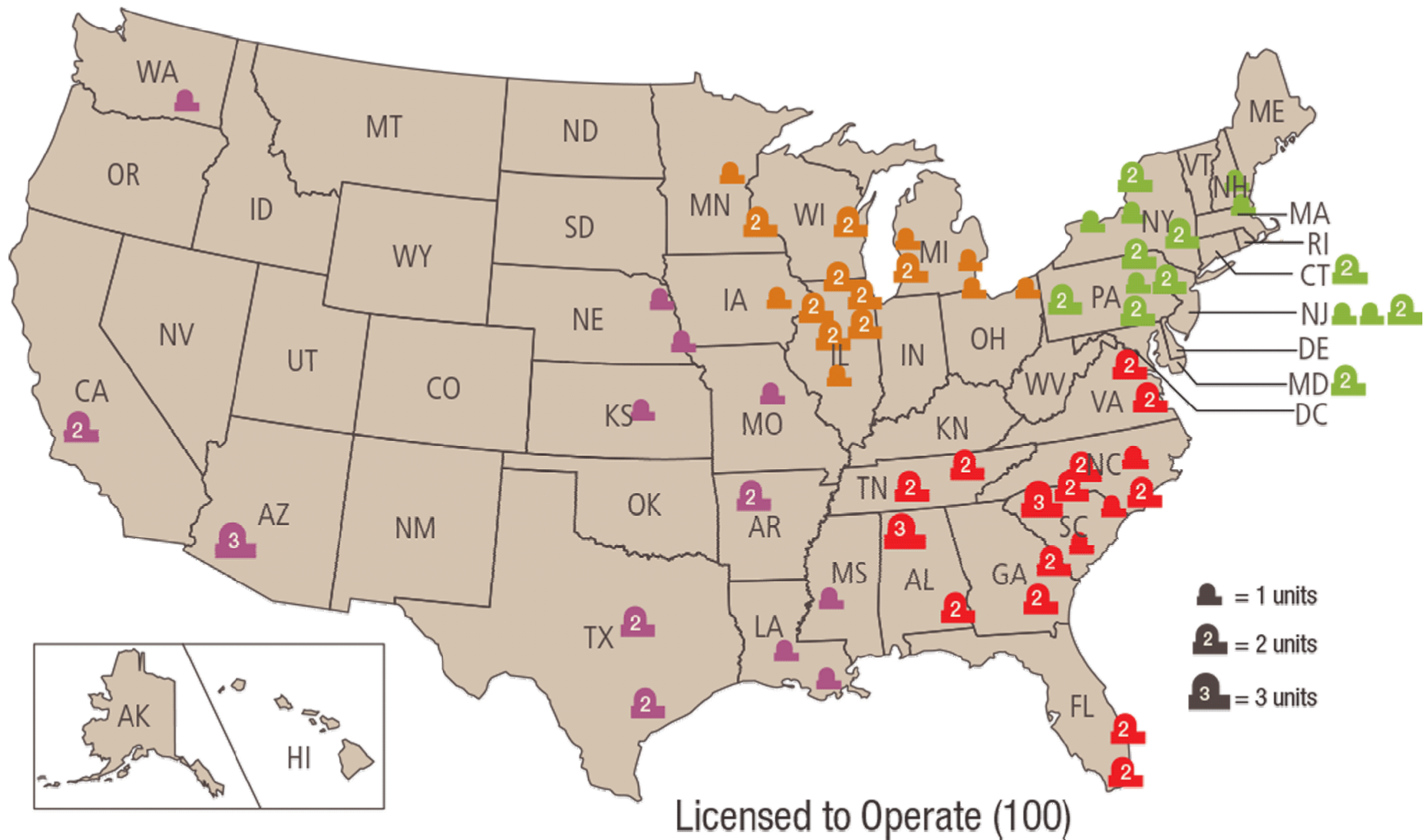
## Reactor Oversight Framework
