

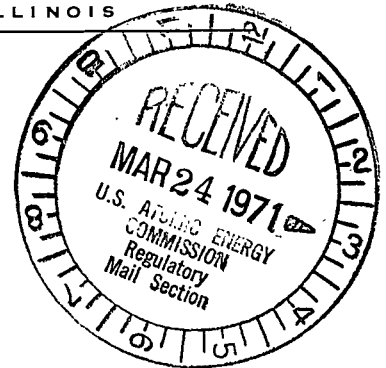

Subject: Additional Information concerning the operation of Dresden Unit 2

Dear Dr. Morris:

This is in response to your letter of February 16, 1971 concerning required additional information on several matters related to the operation of Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 2. Attached hereto are the reports which you requested in your letter. The report numbers correspond to the items listed in your letter.

The report concerning our schedule for the design, installation, and operation of emission reducing equipment, and the report concerning the results of our evaluation of the cause of the failed fuel on Dresden Unit 2, are not included in this submittal. The report concerning off-gas emissions will be filed with you prior to June 1, 1971. The report concerning the evaluation of the cause of failed fuel will be finalized after the current refueling outage so as to include additional information which may result from inspection of the fuel currently being removed from Dresden Unit 2.

If you have any further questions, please let us know. In addition to three signed originals, 19 copies of this submittal are also being transmitted.

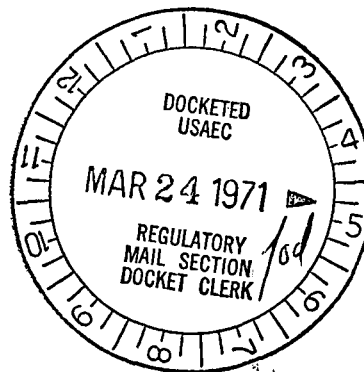
