Dear Mr. Goorevich:

Enclosed is an application (XSNM3763/02), dated March 22, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission from Edlow International Company as an Agent for Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation, requesting amendment No. 02 to its existing license, XSNM3763/01. The license presently authorizes the export of low-enriched uranium to Australia for fuel and medical isotope production at the OPAL reactor.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) increase the quantity of uranium being shipped by 520 kilograms (kg) for a new cumulative total of 1072 kg of uranium, enriched to a maximum of 19.95%, and 2) change the addresses for two of the intermediate foreign consignees.

Assurances from Australia, Argentina, EURATOM, and the Republic of Korea that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation, are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.
