Mr. Lawyer:

Good morning. My apology for the delay in responding to your latest inquiry below; however, I wanted to wait as long as possible in hopes that our POC from U.S. Army North would be able to provide us with the information we had requested. As you may recall, in addition to revising some of the information we had originally submitted, we were on-hold/waiting for feedback on: the actual location in Chattanooga, TN. that the training would be conducted; the actual location in Chattanooga, TN for which the radiological sources would be stored; and correspondence from the property owner that confirmed their knowledge and acceptance of radiological sources being used on their property.

Unfortunately, we did not obtain this information within the requested timeframe (i.e. Jeff & I established a drop-dead date of 4/18/17) and as such, I have informed our POC that RAP Region 2 will not be able to support/participate in the training activity with the 45th National Guard Civil Support Team!!

This process has definitely been a learning experience for Jeff and me and we sincerely appreciate the documentation you provided and your assistance in working with us to ensure you were getting the necessary information. You have been extremely patient throughout this ordeal and I definitely understand that the NRC has a process in place for granting these requests that requires time to coordinate with multiple entities and it is not appropriate to request further timeline extensions. Should we receive, from our customers, similar requests in the future, having gone through this effort will be very beneficial. Again, thank you for your support and please let me know if you have any questions.
