Dear Administrator:

Up-side Radiological Services, LLC (USRS) will be initiating certain activities at the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) Yard at the Naval Air Station Jacksonville, FL under the Nuclear Materials License listed above. In accordance with license condition 18 A, USRS is providing notification to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission that activities will begin under our license on April 24, 2017.

The Department of the Navy has determined that the site is subject to exclusive federal jurisdiction. The site lies entirely within corporate boundaries of the City of Jacksonville, County of Duval, State of Florida, but is controlled by the Navy.

The activities USRS will perform include taking possession of 15 B-25 boxes containing low levels of radium-226 (Ra-226) contaminated soil and debris. In addition, USRS will perform remediation of Survey Unit 3 to approximately 2 feet below ground surface. The remediation is expected to generate 648 cubic yards of soil and debris contaminated with low levels of Ra-226, which will be characterized, packaged, profiled, and transported for disposal to a licensed disposal facility.

Once the remediation has been completed, USRS will conduct a Multi-Agency Radiation Survey and Site Investigation Manual (MARSSIM) survey. The MARSSIM survey is designed such that if no contamination is identified, the data can be used to support unrestricted release of the site. The project is expected to

Under license condition 13, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will delineate license responsibilities between the licensees, in consultation with the Department of the Navy's Radiological Affairs Support Office, which will be forwarded to your office as soon as possible.


