Dear Commissioners:

On January 11, 2017, pursuant to the Commission Memorandum and Order dated January 4, 2017 (CLI-17-01), the NRC Staff filed with the Commission the "NRC Staff Best Estimate of Time for Concluding Consultations" in the Turkey Point COL mandatory proceeding. In the Staff January 11 filing, the Staff committed to updating the status of the consultations by April 14, 2017. On April 13, 2017, the Staff updated the status of consultations but inadvertently filed the update in the contested Turkey Point COL proceeding rather than on the mandatory proceeding docket. In order to place the status update on the correct docket and ensure service on all persons on the mandatory proceeding service list, the Staff is serving the April 13 status report on the mandatory hearing docket. The status of consultation remains unchanged from the status reported on April 13. The Staff regrets the error.
