To the Nuclear Regulatory Commission:

I am writing with regard to Waste Control Specialists' (WCS) application for storage of tons of irradiated nuclear fuel and high-level radioactive waste from nuclear reactors around the country.

You will receive many detailed discussions of the damage that will be caused by thousands of unnecessary nuclear waste shipment across the US.

So I will just point out that the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) must include the risks of national transportation including transportation methods, specific routes, and all their potential impacts. The public comment period should be extended to enable parties along all potential routes to comment.

Despite assurances that accident damage would be minimal, real life disasters have been known to exceed the worst anticipated scenarios.

The best way to deal with nuclear waste is not to create it. Shut down nuclear facilities and support renewable energy.
