Subject: Dresden Station Units 2 and 3 - Revision to Modification 73-1 to the Safety Analysis Report, AEC Dkts 50-237 and 50-249

Dear Mr. O'Leary:

The subject Modification was submitted to you March 1, 1973. The commitment made in the Modification to prepare Dresden and Quad-Cities Station procedures required by Regulatory Guide 1.33 has been completed, and the new procedures will be implemented by October 1974. In accordance with Modification 73-1, the existing station procedures are being reviewed for conformance to the requirements, recommendations, and guidelines of ANSI N18.7 (formerly ANS 3.2) by March 1, 1975. It has become apparent during this review that revision of station procedures to meet the requirements of ANSI N18.7 will not be completed by March 1, 1975. This is an ambitious task requiring several more man-years of effort to complete. The schedule for implementing procedures to comply with ANSI N18.7 will be extended until March 1, 1976.

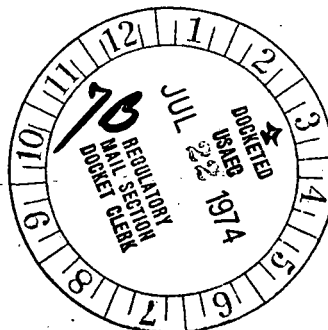
