

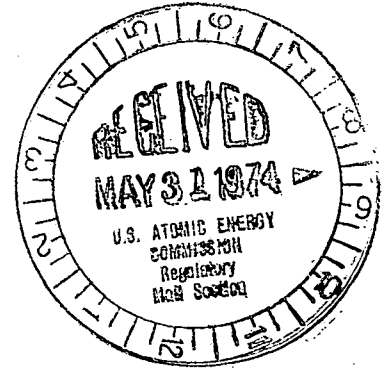



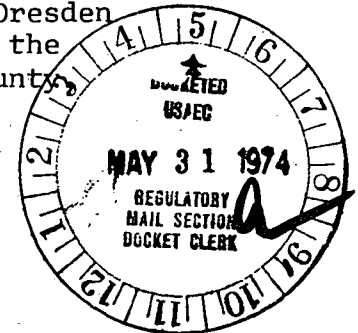


Dear Mr. O'Leary:


