Attached is Supplement A to Special Report No. 22, "Dresden Unit 2 Startup Test Report". This supplement contains information concerning the vibration measurements performed on Dresden Unit 2 during its startup which are considered proprietary by General Electric Company and Commonwealth Edison Company. This information is furnished to Commonwealth Edison Company and the Atomic Energy Commission for the purpose of reporting the results of the vibration test measurements performed on Dresden Unit 2 during the startup program and the comparison of these results with the design criteria.

This information is unpublished and is considered to be proprietary by the General Electric Company. Previous submittals concerning vibration tests have been considered proprietary and approved as such by the AEC. An example would be Amendment No. 19 to the Quad-Cities Final Safety Analysis Report, AEC Docket Nos. 50-254 and 50-265.

It is hereby requested that the AEC withhold Supplement A to Dresden Special Report No. 22 from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 (b). It is believed that public disclosure of this information is not required in the public interest and that public disclosure would adversely affect the interests of the General Electric Company.



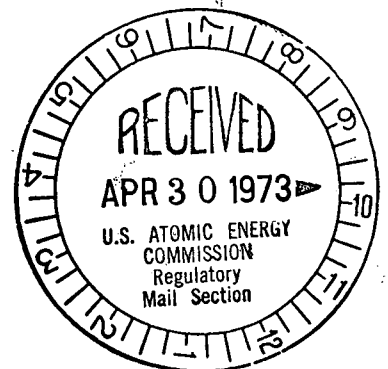
