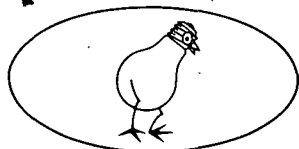

Subject: Application for conversion of Provisional  
Operating License DPR-19 to a Full Term  
License

Dear Mr. O'Leary:

Provisional Operating License No. DPR-19 for Dresden Unit 2 will expire on December 22, 1972. The purpose of this letter is to make application for conversion of this provisional license to a full term license permitting operation at power levels not to exceed 2527 MWt.

Dresden Unit 2 is an identical unit to Dresden Unit 3. A full term license, DPR-25, was issued for Dresden Unit 3 on January 12, 1971, and expires October 14, 2006. The AEC in Amendment No. 1 dated March 2, 1971 to license DPR-25 found that Dresden 3 could be operated at steady state power levels not to exceed 2527 MWt without endangering the health and safety of the public.

As required by paragraph 3C of License DPR-19, for Dresden Unit 2, Semi-Annual Reports dated August 28, 1970, February 26, 1971, August 26, 1971, February 25, 1972 and September 1, 1972 have been submitted describing the actual operating experiences of Dresden Unit 2 with regard to its various features, characteristics and components.

Application is hereby made for a full term license to operate Dresden Unit 2 at power levels not to exceed 2527 MWt.

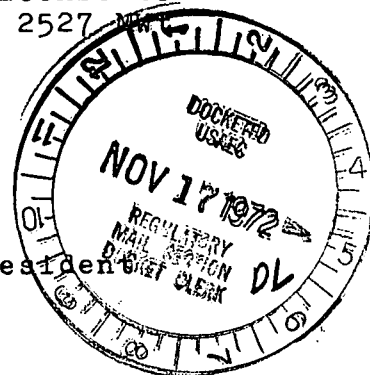
