

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

In response to your letter dated June 25, 1974, attached is Amendment No. 5 to the Dresden Station Unit 2 Application for Conversion from Provisional to Full-Term Operating License (FTOL). The attached amendment contains responses to Questions 1, 2 and 6 of your letter and instructions for incorporating these responses with previous FTOL amendments concerning the same subjects. Responses to the other questions in your letter will be provided separately in the following submittals:

Question 3 - Quality Assurance - A response to this question has been submitted to you in a letter dated August 22, 1974.

Question 4 - Pressure Boundary Integrity - In response to this question, appropriate proposed Technical Specification changes were submitted to the Acting Director, Directorate of Licensing, on August 28, 1974.

Question 5 - Emergency Plan - A revised emergency plan has been under development for several months. It is expected to complete the revisions, obtain Onsite and Offsite approvals, and submit an emergency plan to you by September 13, 1974.
