Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would appreciate information regarding "Missouri Steel Castings" located on E. 3rd Street in Joplin, MO.

Specifically; 1) What functions did MO Steel Castings perform during WWII and thereafter, pertaining to nuclear/radioactive works.

2) What are/is the hazardous substance(s) being released from the current "Landfill" located beneath MO Steel Castings, that is emitting/releasing 1 pound to 777 million pounds, annually, (requiring the City of Joplin to purchase the 5 homes surrounding MO Steel Castings, as a "Buffer")?

Missouri Steel Castings was owned by Fenix and Scisson (FSN). They were the former engineers for the Atomic Energy Agency. They also owned mines in Oronogo and Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri. One of the mines is called "Trinity".

3) What operations did Fenix and Scisson perform in, under or above their mines, within Jasper County, pertaining to nuclear/radioactive and or hazardous wastes ('slightly radioactive') such as NORM and TENORM 'naturally' radioactive gas, oil, or "rocket fuels" or "Nuclear Fuels" and our our "Radioactive Lead" known as "Mississippi Valley Type Lead" (MVT) and or Joplin-lead?

FSN's job descriptions include:

UNDERGROUND NUCLEAR DETONATIONS  
UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE  
OIL AND GAS/ PIPELINES  
MINING AND UNDERGROUND TUNNELLING  
"OTHER"

Were any or all of these actions performed in Jasper County, Missouri for the Atomic Energy Agency, Military or United States Government? If so, please list each item that was performed and the timeframe of each.

**E.I. Du Pont de Nemours** was located between Joplin and Carthage, Missouri. It later became "Atlas Powder Co.", "Atlas Chemical Co.", ICI, EMI, EBV d/b/a General Dynamics.

Please list any and all nuclear/radioactive functions performed at this (originally) 1,000+ acre location since before World War II, to date; including

4) radioactive explosives, Rocket Fuels, ie; Perchlorate that is radioactive with Chlorine 36. Was it made there, stored there or incinerated there and from what time frame?

5) "Radioactive Pesticides" (whether naturally occurring or not, made there or incinerated or stored there; ie: Beta Lindane, Gamma Lindane aka BHC666)

6) incinerations and or burial of any radioactive products/materials including depleted uranium.
