Dear Mr. Davidson,

This is in reference to your letter dated April 3, 2017, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-35235-01, Docket No. 03038831. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have requested for Jason Canterbury to be your Radiation Safety Officer and qualified as an Authorized User. You have provided certification of training for fixed gauges and non-routine work for fixed gauges. Your license also includes a portable gauge as listed items 6.E., 7.E., 8.E., and 9.E. which requires additional training. Please provide documentation that Mr. Canterbury has received practical training on the use of portable gauges.
2. Please provide the contact information for Mr. Canterbury (Phone, email, and facsimile).
3. The NRC has changed the protocol on how licenses are written. In order to support the new format, please provide the maximum source activity and total activity you wished to be licensed for each device listed in item 9.D. of your current license. Generally each device will be listed as a separate line item in items 6, 7, 8, and 9.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter.
