I reviewed the LCC/Mass Spec Room to assure you that NO CLASSIFIED matter exists in that room. The X-09 lock on the door and the access controls are still active, as are the alarm heads in the room. The room does still contain an alarm box (that is used to send the signals for that area to the CAS) that will be moved prior to the demolition of that structure. With the removal of the classified matter, this room can be effectively removed as a Closed Area (Vault-Type Room) without compromising the protection strategy of that area.
