Dear Mr. Tappert:

In your letter of March 28, 2017, NRC requested a revised schedule for submitting additional information required for the Willow Creek HP program. The information for the HP program related to the Ludeman Project license amendment to Willow Creek license SUA-1341 was submitted to NRC on April 17, 2017.

Based on discussions with our contractor, Uranium One anticipates that the Technical Report (TR) will be submitted to NRC the week of May 7, 2017 as an electronic copy in a pdf format. The Environmental Report (ER) will be submitted 1-2 weeks after the TR and is scheduled for the week of May 22, 2017.

Items identified by NRC on deficiencies associated with the Class III Cultural Resources Inventory have been addressed and were sent to NRC on April 5, 2017. Uranium One submitted a response to the open items identified in the February 22, 2017 public meeting on February 22, 2017 and April 13, 2017. Uranium One has also submitted an addendum to the September 2016 Meteorology and Air Quality on April 21, 2017 to NRC regarding air emission inventory clarifications.

Uranium One believes the above response addresses NRC concerns regarding scheduling as stated in the March 28, 2017 letter.
