This refers to the inspection conducted from April 24-25, 2017, at the Global Nuclear Fuel – Americas, L.L.C. (GNF-A) Wilmington, North Carolina facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the licensee were conducted safely and in accordance with Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection on April 25, 2017, the inspector discussed the findings with members of your staff.

Areas examined during the inspection consisted of fixed site physical protection program for special nuclear material of low strategic significance. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. There were no violations identified.
