Dear Mr. Parker:

Per our phone conversation with you on May 9, 2017, we are providing additional information regarding our request for an amendment to our license dated February 2, 2017.

At this time, we wish to withdraw our request to add the Co-57 Sealed Source XRF device to our license. The device we had intended to use is no longer available to us, and therefore we will not be using the referenced device.

In our request, we also asked that Mr. David Nolan, P.E. be allowed to conduct the nuclear gauge training program for new users and provided information regarding completed training programs. In addition to that information, we would also like to add that Mr. Nolan regularly performed testing using a Humboldt Nuclear Density Gauge (Gauge) in 1996 and 1997 averaging 1500 hours/year. In 1998 he used a gauge for approximately 400 hours, and approximately 100 hours in 1999. Since that time, he has trained and supervised others using portable nuclear density gauges as the manager of the material testing department at SCI Engineering, Inc's St. Charles location.
