If devices listed under GL-11137 have been disposed of, please furnish a report notifying the NRC of the transfer of your generally licensed devices, per the requirements in 10 CFR 31.5(c)(8)(ii). The report must include:

- Name of manufacturer or initial distributor of the device(s), model number, and serial number;
- Name, address, and license number of person receiving the device(s); and
- Date(s) of transfer.

You may mail the report to the following address or, alternatively, you may choose to email it to me. If you choose to send it by email, please make sure to submit an official company letter, signed, and dated.
