JK I strongly urge you to take action against the NRC's recent ^{NOV 5 1972} Berwick licensing proceedings. The NRC is making every roadblock it can to the intervention of this licensing. The Environmental Coalition against Nuclear power and other anti-nuclear groups attempting to intervene in the licensing of Berwick are being thwarted by the NRC deliberately. The NRC told the intervenors they have 14 days to answer 150 questions posed to them by NRC and P.P.L., "Six Months were given to P.P.L. in a similar situation." The NRC is also in effect withholding information on the licensing proceedings by telling E.C.N.P. "if you want information go to Washington and get it." Is this anyway for a federal agency to conduct its affairs?

Please urge your colleagues to take action to make a fair hearing out of the Berwick Licensing Proceedings
