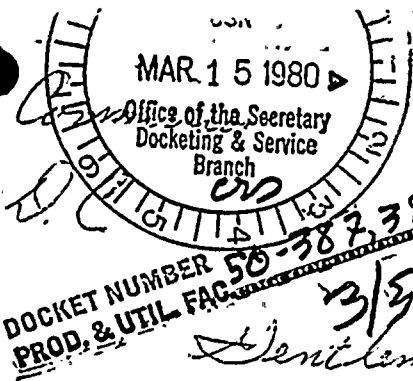

Gentlemen:

I am quite sure you all are aware of "Three Mile Island".
Now let us consider a few factors about the "Berwick" Complex.

Note the proximity of Three Mile Island to Berwick Complex

Note the proximity of both Complexes to the Allingier Hospital at Danville.

Should there be a real drought, there just would not be any water available for cooling purposes. Consider the purity of the cooling water.

Consider very thoroughly the prevailing winds. Consider the dense population in a fifty-mile radius of the Berwick Complex, as well as the "Three Mile Island". Just exactly how thoroughly have you considered evacuation routes and evacuation emergencies?

Note quite well the number of times the continuity of construction was breached by delays, strikes, work stoppages, weather, etc.
