The Draft Supplement is also being made available at the Pennsylvania State Clearinghouse, Governor's Budget Office, Intergovernmental Relations Division, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, and at the Luzerne County Planning Commission, Court House, Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, and the Economic Development Council of Northeast Pennsylvania, Avoca, Pennsylvania. The Draft Supplement is related to the construction and operation of the Pond Hill Low-Flow Augmentation Reservoir. The purpose of the proposed reservoir is to suppy water to the Susquehanna River during periods of low riverflow to replace the water consumptively used by the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station. 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



Pursuant to 10 CFR Part 51, interested persons may submit comments on the Applicant's Environmental Report, as supplemented, the Draft Environmental Statement, and the Draft Supplement to the Draft Environmental Statement for the Commission's consideration. Federal and State agencies are being provided with copies of the Applicant's Environmental Report, the Draft Environmental Statement and the Draft Supplement to the Draft Environmental Statement (local agencies may obtain these documents upon request). Comments are due by May-27, 1980. Upon consideration of comments submitted with respect to the Draft Environmental Statement and the Draft Supplement to the Draft Environmental Statement, the Commission's staff will prepare a Final Environmental Statement, the availability of which will be published in the FEDERAL REGISTER.


