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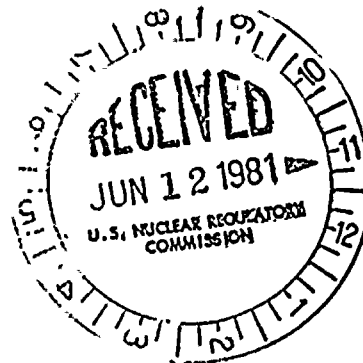
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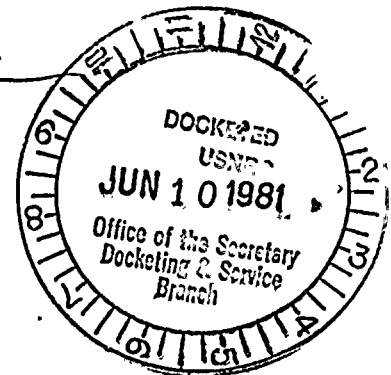

their discovery proceedings".

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

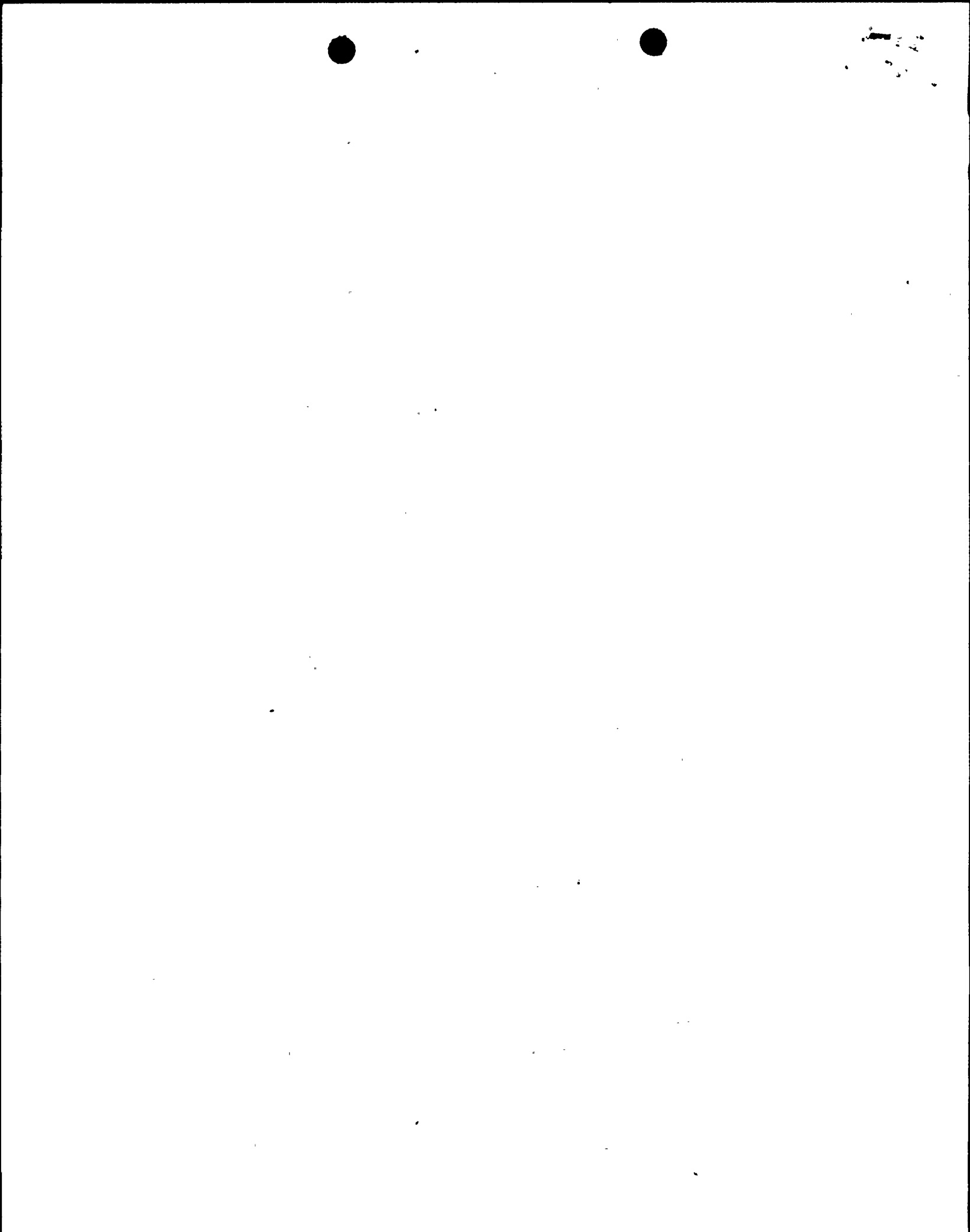
Applicants currently do not intend to file any further discovery requests in this proceeding. Depending on the Licensing Board's ruling on new contentions, however, a limited amount of additional discovery might be appropriate. At the present time, the only discovery responses which are due to Applicants are the Susquehanna Environmental Advocates' answers to Applicants' interrogatories on Contention 6. Pursuant to the Licensing Board's May 20, 1981 Memorandum and Order, these answers are required to be served by June 15, 1981 (twenty days from the date of the Order, plus five days for mailing).

In Citizens Against Nuclear Dangers' May 12, 1981 "Motion Opposed to Dismissal of Contention. . . .", CAND noted that it was "willing to send a small delegation to the Berwick Nuke Construction site . . . to inspect the rail facilities on location . . ." This appears to be a request for new discovery some two years beyond the date established in the Special Prehearing Conference Order. Since CAND has not made any showing of good cause for its delayed request (and since CAND's initial discovery requests dated May 22, 1979 did not address this issue at all), we believe it inappropriate to consider this untimely proposal.

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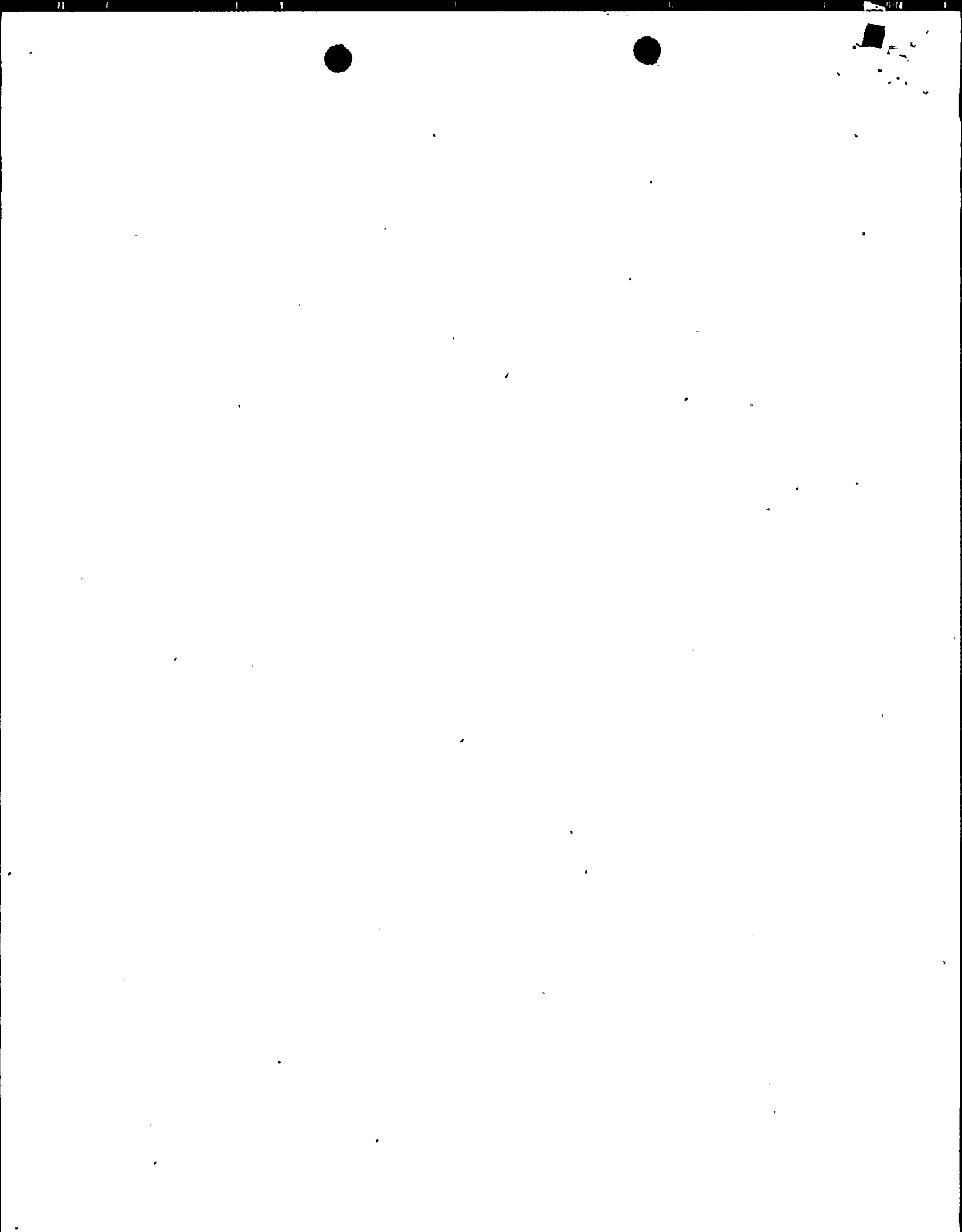
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
