Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In a letter dated August 19, 1981 (PLA-909), PP&L's approach to the operation of the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) was discussed. Since that time, we have further refined the specific responsibilities and assignments for personnel manning the EOF. A description of the significant change follows.

Within approximately one hour of notification, an EOF Support Manager will be in charge at the EOF, and through an orderly transition, have assumed certain responsibilities from the Technical Support Center (TSC). These responsibilities are: overall emergency management; all off-site radiological activities, including dose calculations, projections and assessments and radiological field measurements; protective action recommendations for the public; and communications with the DER/BRP, the state agency responsible for making off-site protective action decisions. In addition, the EOF Support manager will also be responsible for communications with PP&L's corporate office personnel. Communications with the other off-site agencies which are primarily for notification of changes in emergency classification will continue to be made from the TSC.

This arrangement will prevail until the EOF Support Manager and his staff are relieved by the Recovery Manager and his staff who will be travelling from Allentown. We believe this approach provides a high level of support in an emergency while utilizing our resources efficiently.

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
